Exhibits to be put in place between 9.30am and 11am on Sunday morning.

Your entry cards will be available on arrival.

Judging will take place from 11.15am

Classes 1 to 15 - Daffodils must be shown without foliage.

Classes 16 & 17 - Tulips can be shown with foliage.

Exhibits in Classes 21 to 35 will be judged from all angles.

All entries must be from your own home or garden except for Floral arrangements

Only one entry, per class, per person.

Vases will be available for staging exhibits for classes 1 – 17.

Glasses will be available for camellias & trays for pansies/violas

2. Vase of 3 (Div 1) Trumpet Daffodils, yellow
3. Vase of 1 (Div 1) Trumpet Daffodil, white or bi-colour
4. Vase of 3 (Div 1) Trumpet Daffodils, white or bi-colour

5. Vase of 1 (Div 2) Large-cupped Daffodil, yellow
6. Vase of 3 (Div 2) Large-cupped Daffodils, yellow
7. Vase of 1 (Div 2) Large-cupped Daffodil, white or bi-colour
8. Vase of 3 (Div 2) Large-cupped Daffodils, white or bi-colour

9. Vase of 1 (Div 3) Small-cupped Daffodil
10. Vase of 3 (Div 3) Small-cupped Daffodils

11. Vase of 1 (Div 4) Double Daffodil (one flower per stem)
12. Vase of 3 (Div 4) Double Daffodils (one flower per stem)

13. Vase of 3 Daffodils (Two or more flowers per stem, other than Div 1-4)
14. Vase of 3 mini daffodils (any variety)
15. Vase of 9 mixed daffodils (any number of any variety or Division)

16. Vase of 3 Tulips (any colour of the same variety)
17. Vase of 3 Tulips (any variety – can be mixed)

18. A single bloom of Camellia without buds (display glasses are available)
19. 6 cut Pansies or Violas to be exhibited in the tray provided
20. Vase of 3 cut Hyacinths

21. Bowl or pot of Hyacinths (max 9” (23cm) diam. pot)
22. A pot with 1 plant of the Primula family (max 8” (20cm) diam. pot)
23. Foliage pot plant (max 8” (20cm) diam. pot)
24. An Orchid pot plant (max 8” (20cm) diam. pot)
25. A Flowering pot plant (any, other than those mentioned-max 8” diam. pot)
26. A pot of a single bulb of Hippeastrum (Amaryllis)
27. A pot of Cactus or succulent (max 8” (20cm) diam. pot)

28. A single flower of Hellebore - exhibited floating in the dish provided.
29. Vase of 3 stems of Hellebores
30. Vase of 3 stems of Polyanthus
31. Vase of 3 stems of Wallflowers
32. Vase of 3 stems of the same variety of a flowering shrub
33. Vase of flowering shrubs, as many cultivars as possible
34. Vase of garden flowers, as many cultivars as possible (excluding shrubs)
35. Pot of growing Tulips (any number of any varieties), max 9" (23cm) diam pot

36. Special Class – Pot of Daffodils – Bulbs A

37. Special Class – Pot of Daffodils – Bulbs B

Pot size is known as a 3 Ltr 'Deep' – 6" (15.24cm) diam. and 7" (20cm) tall approx.
